




Welcome to Moody! This guide will help you to connect to mbiwireless on your **Windows 7** devices. If you have a different operating system, please refer to its.moody.edu to find the correct guide for your operating system. These instructions assume that you have installed all available updates and that you have a fully functional antivirus software installed. Failure to meet these security requirements may result in delays in connecting your device to the network.


Step 1: Left click on the wireless icon in the lower right-hand corner of your screen and left click on **Open Network and Sharing Center**.




Step 2: After clicking on **Open Network and Sharing Center**, you will see a box like the one below. Click on **Manage wireless networks** in the left-hand column.




Step 3: The next screen displays the wireless networks you have connected to before. In this case, you need to either add **mbiwireless** or make sure it is on the list. This guide assumes you have not added **mbiwireless**, so if you have **mbiwireless** in the list, highlight it and click **Remove**, then go ahead and click **Add** to proceed.




Step 4: Upon clicking **Add**, the window below will display. Click on **Manually create a network profile** to setup the **mbiwireless** network.



Step 5: In the **Network name** field, enter **mbiwireless** and from the drop-down menu next to **Security type**, select **WPA2-Enterprise** and click **Next**.




Step 6: After you have successfully added **mbiwireless**, click on **Change connection settings**:






Step 7: From the mbiwireless Wireless Network Properties box, click on the *Security* tab up at the top. From that same box, click on the **Settings** button next to *Microsoft Protected EAP (PEAP)*.



Step 8: After the Protected EAP Properties box comes up, the Validate Server Certificate box should be **unchecked** as shown below:




Step 9: After unchecking the Validate Server Certificate box, you need to click on the **Configure** button to bring up the Password Configuration box:



Step 10: Close (by clicking *OK*) on all the boxes that are up on your screen. Once every other dialogue box is closed, you will see a dialogue box asking for additional information. Click on it to bring up a box asking for your credentials to authenticate to the network. You will enter your Moody-issued *username* and *password* to continue.




Step 11: You should now be connected to **mbiwireless**, and the wireless icon in your task bar should be as seen below.



NOTE: The following page and steps are applicable only to those who either have been off the network 45 days or more or have never registered with Bradford.

Step 12: To continue with your computer's setup, you will need to open up your browser (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, etc.). Upon opening your browser, you should be redirected to our *Acceptable Use Policy*. In order to continue, you will need to click **Agree**.






Step 13: The page that comes up after clicking **Agree** is the Welcome page. Click on the **Start** link to the right of **MBI Staff and Student**.




Step 14: After clicking **Start**, you will be brought to a Login page. Here, you will enter your Moody-issued *username* and *password* (the same as you entered earlier to join **mbiwireless**) and click **Next** to continue.




Step 15: Clicking **Next** will start a process of downloading **Bradford Persistent Agent**, which scans your computer to make sure you have an up-to-date antivirus program and an updated operating system. This acts as a security measure to make sure we don't get any viruses through and on to our network. Click **Save File** to begin downloading Bradford.

NOTE: Do not close your browser window yet.




Step 16: After clicking **Save File**, your "Downloads" list will come up, and **Bradford Persistent Agent.exe** will be at the top of the list. Double click on the Bradford icon if the download doesn't automatically open.


NOTE: This step differs from browser to browser



Step 17: The **Bradford Persistent Agent Setup Wizard** will help you through the process of setting up Bradford. Click **Next** to allow Bradford to begin installing.



Step 18: You will need to wait a few seconds for Bradford to finish installing.







Step 19: When Bradford has successfully installed you can click **Finish**. Then, a box will pop up asking for you to sign in; enter your Moody-issued *username* and *password* here and click on **Login** to continue.



Step 20: After clicking the **Login** button, Bradford will prompt a scan of your system. This scan of your computer is to ensure your computer meets our security policy. *Please wait until the progress bar reaches its full capacity to proceed.*



Step 21: Once the scan has successfully completed (success happens when your operating system and antivirus program are completely up to date), your browser will display a Success page. You will need to wait 45 seconds before your connection is completely established.



Step 22: When this process has finished, a window will pop up requesting that you close and reopen your browser. Close your browser completely, reopen it, and navigate to your favorite Web page.
