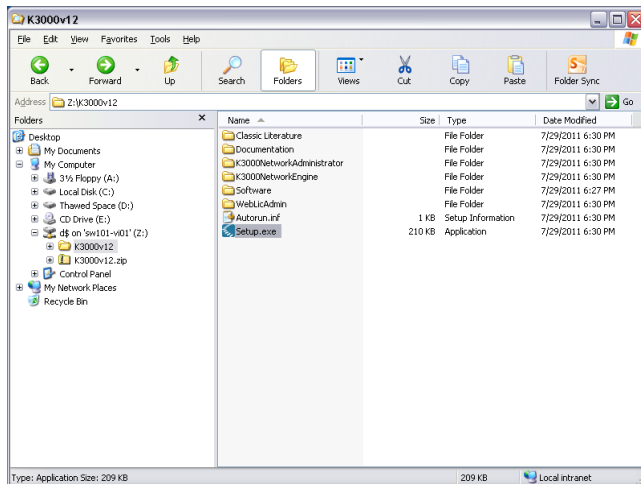


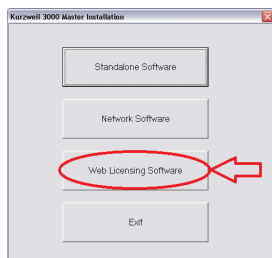
Kurzweil 3000 is an assistive technology, text to speech, learning tool that supports the concept of Universal Design for Learning with a suite of powerful reading, writing, test-taking, and study skill tools that makes curriculum accessible to all students. It is particularly appropriate for students with learning disabilities such as dyslexia, dysgraphia, those who require reading intervention, students struggling with reading comprehension and English Language Learners (ELL).

Installation Steps (Windows)

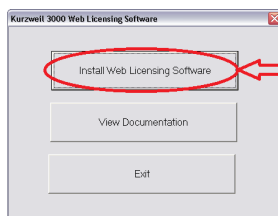
1. Save and close any files that are open on your computer so that they won't be lost when you have to restart your computer at the end of the installation process.
2. Insert the installation disk, or extract the downloadable .zip file (then, find "setup.exe").



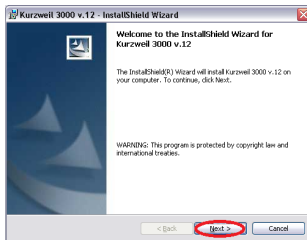
3. Double-click on the "Setup.exe" icon, and then choose "Web Licensing Software."



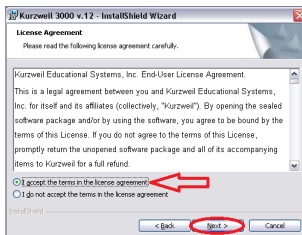
4. Click on "Install Web Licensing Software."



5. On the screen that comes up, click “Next” to continue the installation.



6. Click on the “I accept the terms ...” radio button, and then click “Next.”



7. On the next screen, enter what you would like in the “User Name:” and “Organization:” fields; then click “Next.”



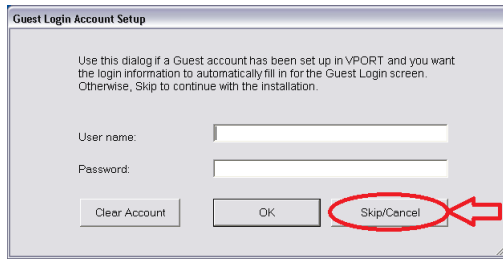
8. On the next screen, select “Complete” for the Setup Type, and click “Next.”



9. Next, click on “Install.”



10. In the “Guest Login Account Setup” window, click “Skip/Cancel.”



11. When the Installation Wizard finishes, click “Finish.”



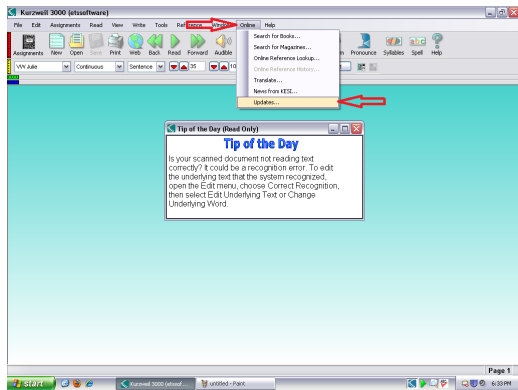
12. When prompted, click “Yes” to restart your computer.



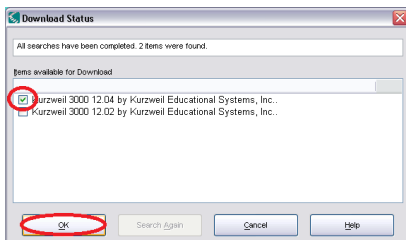
13. After your computer reboots, open the Kurzweil 3000 program and login with the username and password provided by ITS. (Note: Kurzweil will only work when the computer is connected to the Internet.)



14. When Kurzweil has finished loading, from the “Online” menu choose “Update.”



15. Choose the most current version available, and click “OK” to update the software.



16. On the next screen, click “OK” to complete the installation of the update.
